Compulsory retirement affected in pursuance of this rule does not amount to dismissal or removal from service within the meaning of Clause 2 of Article 311 of the constitution and a Government servant so retired can not claim as a matter of right, that he should be given a reasonable opportunity of showing cause against the action proposed to . be taken in regard to him it shall not be necessary, in such cases to follow the procedure laid down for the institution of departmental proceedings against the Government Servant before retiring him compulsorily from Government Service.

Payment in Case of Dismissal, Removal or Suspension

Rule 95:

The pay allowance of govt. servant who is dismissed or removed from service ceases from the date of such dismissal

Rule 96:

The govt. servant under suspension shall be entitled to the following payments –

Subsistence grant at an amount equal to the leave salary which the govt. servant would have drawn, if he had been on leave, on half average pay, or on half pay and in addition cost of living allowance based on such leave salary.
